PARTICIPANT GUIDELINES

- +PARK(ing) Day will take place from 8:00am-4:00pm on Friday, September 20,2019.
- +All participants are required to stay within the boundaries of their assigned parking space.
- +Participants must provide a barrier between their parklet and the vehicular travel lanes. The barrier must be a minimum of 42" tall. The barrier must not create opaque walls around the parklets. Cars, bicyclists, and pedestrians must have a clear line of view to see any cars, bikes, or pedestrians on all sides of the parklet.
- +No commerce or overt advertising is allowed in your parklet. It's okay to say "This park brought to you by XYZ Organization", but parklets cannot look like trade show booths.
- +Parklet construction cannot encroach on vehicular travel lanes at any height.
- +Parklets must have someone present at all times.
- +Parklets are not to contain sod.
- +Stay away from corners.
- +Parklets can only be in the space where and when it's legal to park a car. Please abide by all signs that state restrictions based on handicapped, valet, rush hour, loading zones, and bus stops. The parklet is subject to the same restrictions.
- +All participants are required to leave the space clean and no garbage is to be left behind.



A typical parking space is 8'-0" x 20'-0", but the sizes do vary. Please check your site!
